# School Profile

## Mountain View High School

Mountain View, a comprehensive three-year high school serving the north-central area of Mesa, Arizona, has an enrollment of 2700 students in grades 10-12. With 165 certificated staff and a teacher/student ratio of 1:24, Mountain View High School is fully accredited by the State of Arizona and by the North Central Association of Schools and Colleges.

A large suburban community of 410,000, Mesa is located southeast of Phoenix. The Mesa Unified School District serves 72,000 students in six comprehensive high schools. The Mesa Unified School District includes rural, suburban and urban areas.

Mountain View is a permanent voting member of The College Board.

One-half credit is awarded for successful completion of each semester course. All classes are 55 minutes in length and meet 5 days per week.

## Diploma Requirements

Mesa Public Schools offers two types of high school diplomas. A minimum of 21 Carnegie units of credit is required to earn either diploma. In addition, graduates must pass Arizona AIMS assessments in Reading, Writing and Math. Specific subject requirements are listed below.

## Grading System

Mountain View uses a standard 4.0 grading system. All Advanced Placement (AP) College Prep (CP) and Able and Ambitious (AA) classes are weighted and receive an additional 1.0 value. Weighted courses are indicated on the official transcript by name. Grades in all courses are included in the calculation of the grade point average and class rank.
